The Genesis Process is successful because it deals with subconscious relapse patterns by addressing the underlying faulty belief systems that support them.

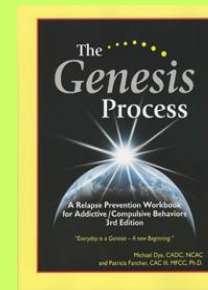
